Many potential new members have concerns regarding the financial obligation of joining a sorority. In order to make an informed decision, the Panhellenic Association would like to provide a range of the one-time fees and semester dues that a potential new member would be accountable for during the first semester of membership.

One-Time Fees

Semester Fees

| Housing Fees: | \$100 |
| Panhellenic Dues: | \$10 |

There is also an obligation by each chapter that members are invited to live on the Chapter floor for at least one year. The chapter floors are located in Lawler-Harkins Residence Hall. There are single rooms and double rooms available on each floor. The pricing for housing on the chapter floors is as follows:

Double Occupancy: \$2,150.00 (two persons per room)

Double-as-Single Occupancy: \$3,225.00 (private room)

Please note: Chapters may have additional charges that are not listed above that are obligated to be paid as well. Those charges will be assessed once the new member has signed her bid card and has been set up on the individual chapter's billing system.
